



## Marine Notice 07 of 2026

*Notice to all Shipowners, Fishing Vessel Owners, Agents, Shipmasters, Skippers, Fishers,  
Yachtsmen and Seafarers*

### Notice of Irish Anglerfish and Megrin Survey (IAMS) 2026 – Leg III, North and Northwest Coasts

#### 1. Notice of Survey

Further to [Marine Notice No. 02 of 2026](#), the Department of Transport has been advised that the third leg of the annual Irish Anglerfish and Megrin Survey (IAMS 2026) will be carried out from **06 to 15 April 2026** to the north and northwest coast of Ireland by the Marine Institute in fulfilment of Ireland's Common Fisheries Policy (CFP) obligations.<sup>1</sup>

The IAMS is a demersal trawl survey consisting of approximately 50 otter trawls, each of 60 minutes' duration, in ICES area 6.a. The approximate location of these hauls is given in the table in Appendix 1 and the map in Appendix 2 to this Marine Notice. The survey will take place within a 3-nautical-mile radius of the indicative positions.

#### 2. Details of Survey Vessel

The survey will be conducted by the **RV Celtic Explorer** (Callsign: **EIGB**). The vessel will display appropriate lights and signals. The vessel will be towing a Jackson demersal trawl during fishing operations.

#### 3. Safety Information

The Marine Institute requests that commercial fishing and other marine operators keep the 3 nm radius around each of the tow points or "stations" clear of any gear or apparatus during the survey period outlined above. While there is no statutory provision for the loss of gear at sea, the Marine Institute will make every effort to avoid gear adequately marked according to legislation<sup>2</sup> that may be encountered in the notified areas.
